Aims of Coogee Kindergarten

- be aware of the individual child and his/her needs and plan a program according to those needs;
- develop an environment in which the child feels secure and cared for;

• encourage parents to participate in order to learn and understand more about children's play and behaviour.

Delivery and collection of children

Children must be dropped off and picked up by an adult.

If someone other than the child's caregivers are collecting them, please advise the teacher of the change when they are dropped off in the morning. Fill out the necessary information in the Child Collection Book located at the Kindy entrance. If a Childcare Centre (other than Camp Australia) are picking up your child, we will require their contact phone number.

Kindy will open the door at 8.35am - Kindy finishes at 2.55pm. IF YOUR CHILD IS LATE, YOU MUST REPORT TO THE SCHOOL OFFICE WITH YOUR CHILD BEFORE ARRIVING TO CLASS AND RECEIVE A 'WELCOME SLIP'. Please endeavour to pick up your child up at the correct time as young children often get distressed if they feel they are being left. Please contact us if you are going to be more then 10 minutes late.

Note: Children are NOT permitted to play on or with the equipment in the playground before and after school.


Money Collection



Any monies for incursions/excursions, P&C fund raising, and book club should be placed in the 'Drop Box' in the front office. EFT is our preferred method of payment but if you must pay cash, please put the money in a *sealed envelope with your child's name*, the purpose for the money and total money included.

Most payments are made to the Coogee Primary School - School Account. Please always check the specified account details, if payment needs to be made to the P&C we will emphasise this in correspondence. Always use the students **SURNAME** as a reference when making any payment to the account.



Personal Information

Please ensure that the information on admission and medical forms are kept up to date. This enables us to contact you if your child becomes sick. Please note: It is the

parents' responsibility if medication needs to be administered. In order for us to take the very best care of your child, we need to know about allergies as soon as possible.

What to wear

The wearing of uniforms and bucket hats is enforced as it adds much to the tone and spirit of the school.

Acceptance of enrolment at a school assumes an agreement between the school, the parent/guardian and the enrolling student, and that the student will dress within the guidelines of the school dress code.

School t-shirts, skirts, shorts, dresses, track suits and hats, are ordered online through Uniform Concepts (order forms and size samples available at the front office). Alternatively, you may visit the store at 26 Solomon Road, Jandakot. Please note faction shirts are NOT required for kindy children.

Labelling/naming each article of clothing and belongings is essential to avoid an accumulation of "Lost Property". Unclaimed lost property is recycled on a regular basis.



School Bag

An open reusable shopping bag would be best suited for a child at kindy over a backpack (see sample image below). This can be any colour or style you choose. The bag below is available to purchase from the school office for \$5.



A change of clothes kept in their school bag is handy in case of accidents (please provide underwear and socks as well).

is packed in a separate labelled lunch box and that both morning tea and lunches are healthy and nutritious.



Waste Free



Coogee Primary School provides opportunities for the children to save the resources by being water wise and paper wise. Please provide your child with a waste free lunch (food packaged in reusable containers).



It is compulsory to wear the approved bucket hat (listed on our uniform order form) outside throughout the whole year. Please label you child's hat with their name. Children are encouraged to take care of their own belongings. Lots items will be place in the "Lost Property Basket". Please check your child's faction before purchasing a hat from the uniform shop.

Birthdays



On your child's birthday, you may like to provide small cakes, small muffins or icy poles. Please check with the classroom teacher regarding any student allergies.

School Grounds



Coogee Primary School has a NO SMOKING and NO DOGS policy on school grounds.





Compass & Connect Communication





Compass and Connect are communication platforms that Coogee PS uses for correspondence. You can also advise of your child's attendance etc. You will be invited via email to join these platforms after your child has commenced school at Coogee Primary. You will need to download the Compass School Manager app to use on your mobile phone.

Late arrivals or departing school

If your child arrives after the siren, you must report to the school office with your child before arriving to class and receive a 'Welcome Slip'.

If your child has to depart school for any reason (appointments, unwell etc.), you must sign them out from the front office to receive an 'Early Release Slip'.

If arriving back from an appointment, the student must also be signed back into the school through the office. A 'Welcome Slip' will be given to notify staff that the student is signed back in.



Absentee

If your child is absent, you can advise school via Compass App, CONNECT, email coogee.ps@education.wa.edu.au¹ or phone 6595 4900. If your child has an unexplained absence from school, you will receive link via text message to respond to.

How you can help your child



- Read to your child as often as possible. Story reading to a child every day encourages success with early literacy.
- Ensure that your child has adequate sleep and arrives at school feeling fit and well. It's no fun being away from your Parent/Carer when you're feeling sick. The best place for an unwell child is at home.
- Show an interest in what they do at Kindy ask questions e.g. what was the best part of today?
- Discuss with us, any information which will help us to understand your child.
- Provide healthy food and drink.
- Praise their efforts.
- Listen to your child's ideas and comments.
